What you'll need: internet access

There are teams all around us. Even when you can't see them, there are things going on around you.

- Go outside and see what animals and insects you can see.
- Make a list of some of the creatures you see. How do you think those creatures work as a team?
- When you come back into the house, use the internet to research how those creatures work in a team.

Think about the following:

- How do the creatures communicate with each other?
- How is their team structured? Which role is undertaken by which team member?
- Is there a leader?
- How do they learn from one another?
- Do you think they make a good team?

Extension: write up your research and present it to someone in your household or to a friend or family member online. Remember to structure your research project with an introduction, your finds and then finish with a conclusion.
